## THE PROPERTY (Cost to insure)

When dependents become part of the benefit plan, **individual cost for health insurance increases** to \$5,181, dental increases to \$662, and vision increases to \$219. Similarly, the cost to employers of insuring dependents increases significantly for health (\$10,015), dental (\$566), and vision (\$295).
